Scope	This Advice Note applies to Standard Development Groups whose National Forest Stewardship Standards were approved or passed the stage of second public consultation before 1st July 2018, when FSC-STD-60-004 V2-0 was published (see Annex 2).

At their 68 th meeting in March 2015, the FSC Board of Directors approfirst version of the FSC-STD-60-004 <i>International Generic Indicators</i> starting point for developing National Standards. In June 2018, the Board approved a second version of this document the changes described in FSC-STD-60-004 V2-0 <i>International Generators</i> , Section E Preamble.			
Background	 The FSC Board of Directors decided that: Standard Development Groups shall incorporate all new or revised IGI from this version (V2-0) (see Annex 1) into their National Standards under development, in cases where the second consultation has not yet started. Standard Development Groups, whose National Standards have passed the stage of second consultation, or have already been approved (see Annex 2), shall incorporate all new or revised IGI from this version (V2-0) 		





	into their National Standards within 24 months of the effective date of V2-0 (being this deadline 30 June 2020).					
	Since then, different groups of stakeholders have raised concerns regarding the additional work outside the normal cycle of review and revision of the standards, stakeholder fatigue, the challenge to reunite Standard Development Groups (often dissolved once the standard development is completed), cost implications, creation of bottlenecks in the standard assessment and decision making process, etc.					
	This Advice Note formally implements the decision made by the FSC Board in January 2020 to address these concerns and to streamline and facilitate the transfer of IGIs V2-0 to National Forest Stewardship Standards.					
	Standard Development Groups, whose National Forest Stewardship Standard passed the stage of second public consultation or were approved before 01 July 2018 shall:					
Advice	 incorporate the new and revised indicators introduced with FSC-S 004 International Generic Indicators V2-0 the latest at the next sch revision of their National Forest Stewardship Standard, and 					
	submit a final draft for decision making to the FSC secretariat within five (5) years of the effective date of their national standard developed according to IGI V1-0. Annex 1. Changes to the IGI from V1-0 to V2-0					
	New and revised IGIs incorporated to IGI V2-0 were result of the:
